STATEMENT

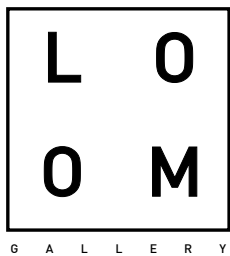
Can you tell the difference between Dawn And Sunset if you are still asleep?

It's a temporary perpetually stasis.
