


Born 1994 in Reading, UK Lives in London, UK

The work of Benjamin Jones centres on photographic representations of nature and photography's capacity to poetically form meaning.

He is interested in how we relate to the natural world through images and the experience shaped by a photographic object. This informs a practice spanning representational and abstract series, of specifically analogue photographic prints.

The language of photographic materiality, it's specific relationship to touch, light and time, shapes this approach.

Photography is always a partial view, defined by technology, material and perspective; a subjectivity and abstraction from reality evident across these monochromatic groups of work.



Thematically referencing seasonal shifts, differing scales of time, botanical growth and accretion, decay and entropy; there is a constant attempt to create artworks with a poetic and associative capacity that connect us to a sense of the unfolding world outside of the work and gallery.

Each print is unique, with Jones returning to certain photographs repeatedly over a period of years to be re-interpreted; proposing an evolving rather than fixed relationship with images. Other prints result from experimental processes that embrace chance and blindness. These works have been exhibited and collected in the UK and Europe, as well as being held in the collection of the Museo del Novecento in Milan.

They have been developed both domestically and through various residencies, including the permanent installation To Live Inside a Second, residing in Pieve Tesino, Italy. Journals and publications including Camera Austria, M-A (A Space Between) and Photomonitor feature his work alongside a number of stand alone catalogues.

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
